■ Oral presentations, Case reports, Posters will be organized to allow international exchange between trainees, residents, ORL specialists and experts.

■ Direct anatomic dissection and live retransmission will be shown in collaboration with Pr Santini 's Head and Neck University Centre and with the LION (Life International Otolaryngology Network).

The format of the EAORL-HNS meeting is mainly designed to bring up-to-date the therapeutic skills of participants through direct exposure to the "best methods" of daily clinical practice.

The venue of the meeting is Acropolis Conference Centre located in the heart of Nice, the capital of the beautiful Côte d'Azur.

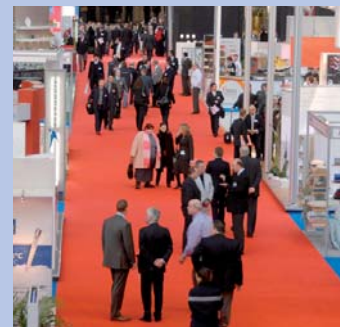
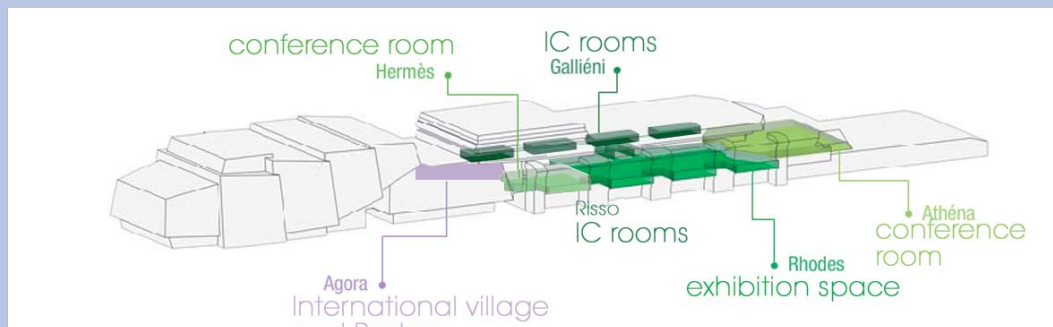
