

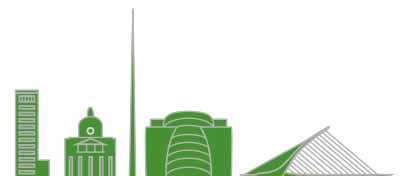

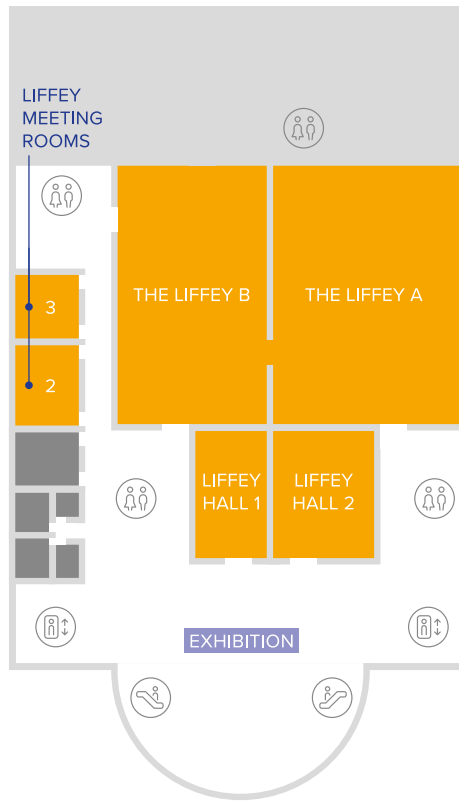


FLOOR PLAN

GROUND FLOOR

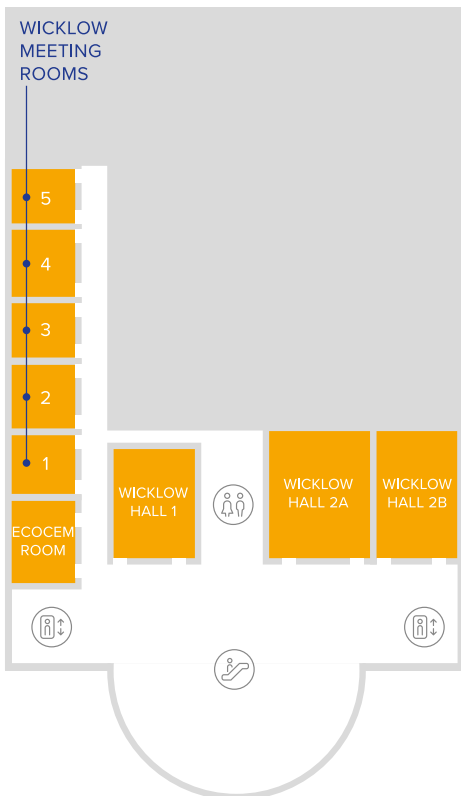


LEVEL 1 – Liffey Level

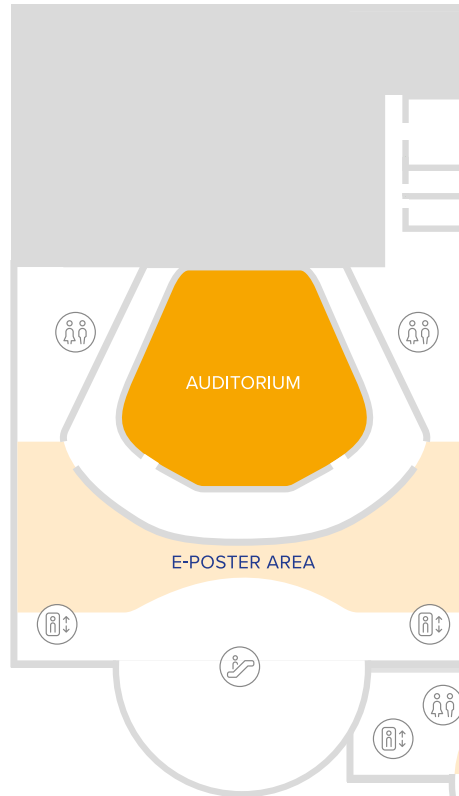

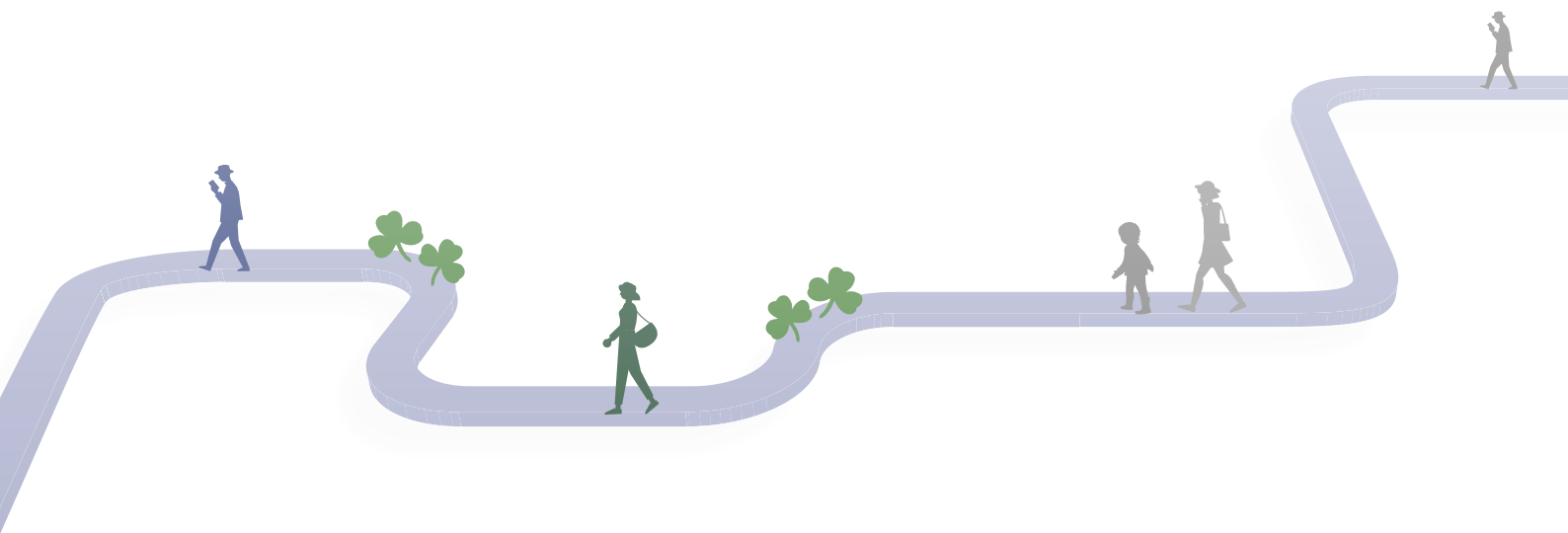

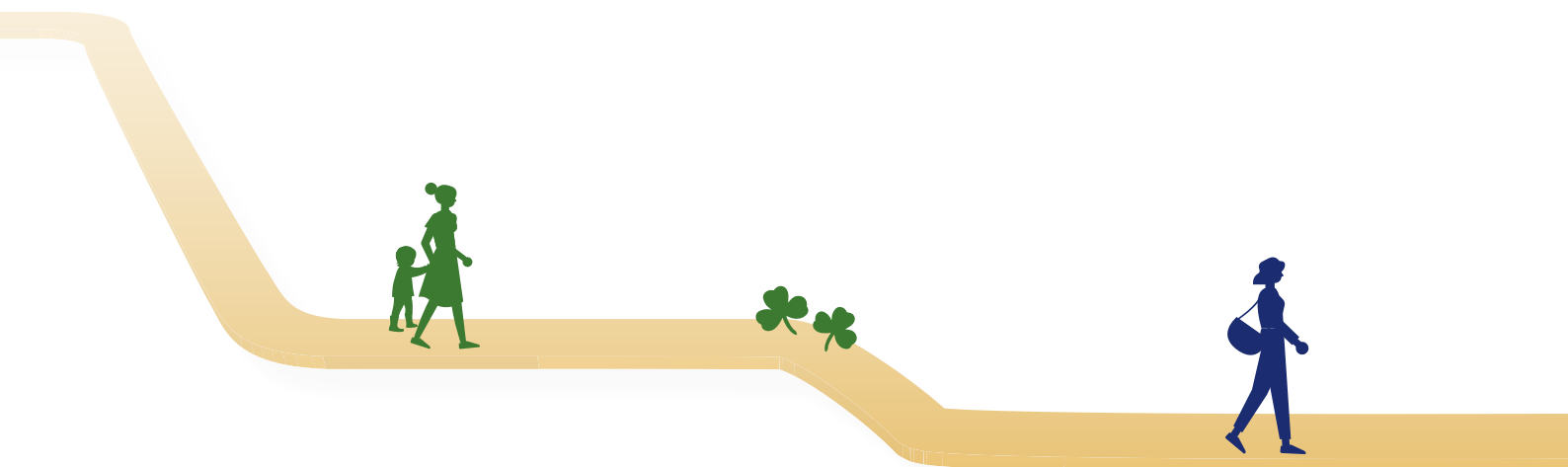
